

Success Time - Dr. Conner

Every day, students have the opportunity to focus on being successful at school! For students in K-2, there are two teachers in each room. During "Success Time", the teachers work with small groups of students to focus on areas of need in reading and math. In addition, the teachers utilize a variety of programs including Zearn and Moby Max to provide additional practice based on individual student levels.

For grades 3-6, "Success Time" looks a little different. After lunch, students break into small groups with a variety of teachers. Most groups average 5-6 students. The groups focus on helping students with areas of struggle in reading or math, but also pushing students ahead who have mastered topics. Moby Max is also utilized to provide additional practice based on individual student levels.

I have been helping with groups for the past few weeks. This is a photo of my group being focused on word work! We were practicing with affixes.

I am so proud of all the hard work that our students and staff! We have a dedicated group of teachers who are focused on ensuring our students find success in school!!!
